- 2. The Receiver is authorized to terminate the 401(k) Plan.
- 3. The Receiver is authorized and empowered to execute and file all documents required to terminate the 401(k) Plan and take all other actions necessary to implement the relief granted in this Order.
- 4. In accordance with the 401(k) Plan, the fees and expenses incurred to assist in the administration and termination of the 401(k) Plan shall be charged and deducted directly from the assets of the 401(k) Plan.
 - 5. This Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon entry.
