ORDER SETTING BAR DATES FOR FILING PROOFS OF CLAIM FOR ALL CREDITORS OTHER THAN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND APPROVING THE FORM AND MANNER OF NOTICE

Upon consideration of the motion ("Motion")¹ of Matthew Brash of Newpoint Advisors Corporation, not individually, but solely in his capacity as receiver ("Receiver"), pursuant to the Amended Order Appointing Limited Receiver, dated July 31, 2025 ("Receivership Order") [ECF No. 52], requesting the entry of an order (i) fixing a bar date that for all creditors of Defendants to assert Claims against the assets of the receivership estate for Claims arising prior to the entry of the Receivership Order; (ii) approving a proposed form and manner of notice of the bar date ("Bar Date Notice"); and (iii) authorizing the Receiver to use funds of the Receivership Estate to publish notice of the Bar Date; due and proper notice of the Motion having been provided; it appearing that there is good cause to grant the relief requested; it is therefore ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The Motion is granted as to all creditors of Defendants including all governmental units other than the United States of America and its agencies (the "<u>United States</u>"), to which the requirements of this order do not apply.
- 2. **October 31, 2025**, is fixed as the deadline (the "<u>Bar Date</u>") for all creditors of Defendants including all governmental units other than the United States to assert Claims against the assets of the estate created by this receivership ("<u>Receivership Estate</u>") for Claims arising prior to July 15, 2025 ("<u>Pre-receivership Claims</u>").
- 3. The notice of the Bar Date attached as <u>Exhibit 1</u> to this Order ("<u>Bar Date Notice</u>") is approved, and the electronic proof of claim form (an "<u>Electronic Proof of Claim</u>") available online at www.gscreceivershipclaims.com/ is approved.

¹ Capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Motion.

- 4. The Receiver's use of funds to publish the Bar Date Notice, or an abbreviated form thereof, in a newspaper of general circulation in Oakland, California; Seattle and Tacoma, Washington; and Savannah, Georgia is approved.
- 5. All proofs of Pre-receivership Claims must be signed and filed with Newpoint Advisors Corporation ("Newpoint") using the Electronic Proof of Claim available at www.gscreceivershipclaims.com/.
- 6. For any proof of claim to be properly and validly filed, a signed Electronic Proof of Claim Form, along with supporting documentation, must be filed online so as to be actually received by Newpoint on or before 11:59 p.m. central time on the Bar Date. Any proofs of claim sent by personal delivery, messenger, U.S. mail, facsimile, email submission or any other method will not be accepted.
- 7. All Electronic Proofs of Claim shall be deemed filed at the time that they are actually received by Newpoint.
- 8. The Bar Date shall apply to each and every Pre-receivership Claim, except for: (a) a Pre-receivership Claim asserted by any person or entity that has already properly filed with the Court a proof of claim against the Receivership Estate; and (b) a Pre-receivership Claim asserted by any person or entity whose Pre-receivership Claim against the Receivership Estate has previously been allowed by order of the Court.
- 9. Any person or entity who is required but fails to file a proof of Pre-receivership Claim in accordance with this Order on or before the Bar Date will be forever barred, estopped and enjoined from (a) asserting any such Pre-receivership Claim against Defendants or the Receivership Estate, and (b) receiving a distribution on account of such claim from the Receivership Estate.
- 10. Notwithstanding anything in this Order to the contrary, nothing shall preclude the Receiver from objecting on any grounds to any Pre-receivership Claim.

GSC Enterprises, Inc., et al.*, pending in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division ("Court"), Case No. 25-cv-7909 ("Case").

On September 2, 2025, the Court entered an order ("<u>Bar Date Order</u>") in the Case requiring all persons, entities and governmental units (except for the United States of America), who have or may have a Claim (defined below) against any of the Defendants in this Case that arose prior to July 15, 2025 (a "<u>Pre-receivership Claim</u>"), to file proof of such Pre-receivership Claim on or before <u>October 31, 2025</u> ("<u>Bar Date</u>") and assert such Pre-receivership Claims against the assets of the estate created by this receivership ("<u>Receivership Estate</u>").
